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A few weeks ago, the world's most important press agencies took notice of the above painting. After having been removed from the walls of the Gotemborg Museum of World Culture, it sparked an international controversy about eroticism, women and Islam. Some Muslims consider the combination of a Koran sura and erotic imagery a provocation.

The young artist, born in Algeria and now residing in Paris, will not only present her paintings but will also show her recent video L'appartement, produced in cooperation with dancer and choreographer Brigitte Dumez.

Louzla Darabi studied arts at Ecole des Beaux-Arts as well as natural and earth science at the Paris VI University. She is presently working on a number of international projects.
